




Distribution of Electoral Bags for the 2024 Regional Elections is carried out in order and safety



The Supreme Electoral Council, through the General Directorate of Logistics Organization and Electoral Warehouse and in coordination with the Municipal Electoral Councils (MEC), on February 28, distributed the Electoral Suitcases for the “Victorious Elections Caribbean 2024” that will be held this year in March 3 in the Autonomous Regions of the North and South Caribbean Coast, where 14 political organizations participate in five boxes on the Electoral Ballot.

“Today (February 28) the Electoral Suitcases are ready to be transferred to the municipalities of the North Caribbean Coast and South Caribbean Coast, which we have strictly ensured so that each of them




conforms to the materials it must contain” , emphasized the President of the Supreme Electoral Council, Brenda Rocha, who presided over the event.

The transfer of the Electoral Material has been protected by the Nicaraguan Army, which has provided all types of transportation: land, air and naval; as well as radio communication equipment, for the protection of objectives throughout the national territory.


The Commander in Chief of the Nicaraguan Army, General Julio César Avilés Castillo, expressed: “We reiterate to the Supreme Electoral Council that they count on our efforts so that these Regional Elections are developed with the desired success. Everything we do is thought about the well-being of our people, that is why we say that we are the people themselves in uniform working for their own benefit.”

Likewise, the National Police provides support for the security and protection of the 751 Vote Receiving Boards in the 308 Voting Centers of the 30 Electoral Districts



corresponding to the Autonomous Regions of the North Caribbean Coast and South Caribbean Coast.

In that sense, the Director of the National Police, First Commissioner, Francisco Javier Díaz Madriz, also stated: "We will guard the Computing Centers, Transmissions, as well as the return of the Electoral Material." Furthermore, "In compliance with our constitutional missions... we will guarantee order and security, through the implementation of preventive public and intelligence actions, so that Caribbean families come to exercise their right to vote and elect their regional authorities."




Political Organizations end Electoral Campaign in peaceful coexistence



In accordance with article No. 74 of Law No. 331, Electoral Law and Activity Number 24 of the Electoral Calendar of these 2024 Regional Elections, the Political Parties and Alliances of Political Parties concluded on February 28 of the current year, with the Electoral Campaign period, which began on the 9th of the same month.



During the Electoral Campaign process, the Political Organizations participating in the “Victorious Elections Caribbean 2024” made their political, social and economic proposals known to citizens through different media, including the social media platform.



Likewise, banners, blankets and advertising brochures are used on the main streets of the municipalities of the Autonomous Regions of the Northern and Southern Caribbean Coast.

In this sense, this State Power recognizes full compliance by the Political Parties and Alliances of Political Parties with the Electoral Ethics Regulations that regulated the 2024 Regional Elections Campaign, in which the ethical norms and principles were established as democratic processes that should have been fulfilled by the Political Organizations, natural and legal persons that are participants in this democratic process.

The Supreme Electoral Council reiterates that through compliance with electoral regulations and the laws established in the Constitution Policy of the Republic, the development of an Electoral Campaign in an environment of peace, tranquility and tolerance was guaranteed in these Regional Elections on March 3.




The period of Electoral Silence of the “Victorious Elections Caribbean 2024” begins



In accordance with the provisions of article No. 85 of Law No. 331, Electoral Law, and Activity Number 25 of the Electoral Calendar, on February 29, the electoral silence began, which both the Political Parties and Alliances of Political Parties as well as the citizens of the Autonomous Regions of the North and South Caribbean Coast, must comply with strict rigor in the face of the Regional Elections on March 3.

During this period, prior to the “Victorious Elections Caribbean 2024”, the candidates for Members of the Regional Councils must refrain from







campaigning or promoting their candidacies.

In this sense, in compliance with the provisions of Law No. 331, Electoral Law, Political Parties and Alliances of Political Parties cannot disseminate electoral propaganda, thus guaranteeing a Fair and Transparent Electoral Process.

The objective of electoral silence is to allow voters to reflect on their options independently and without external interference, before exercising their constitutional right to vote.




SEC has the means of communication to disseminate information corresponding to the Electoral Process



In accordance with article 85 of Law No. 331, Electoral Law: “Seventy-two hours before voting day, all activity of the electoral campaign will cease and the media will be at the command of the Supreme Electoral Council to



disseminate the information on time correspondent to the electoral process.


